

**The Connellsville Campsite is located near GAP mile marker 89  
behind Martin's Plaza, 800 Vanderbilt Rd, Connellsville, PA  
15425. Located at the campsite:**

Parking lot for overnight parking, whole area is complete with video surveillance

4 Adirondack Shelters – FREE for one night on a first come, first served basis.

Large flat area behind the shelters for tents and sleeping bags, 2 covered picnic tables and 2 charcoal grills with trash bins. Frost free water fountain and toilet facility available 24/7/365. Connellsville Police Dept. is available for problems (724-628-2020) and the area is under video surveillance.



Martin's Grocery is 100 yds. away with 16 hour supplies, deli, pharmacy, restroom.

On our Blue Building by the shelters are outlets mounted on the outside wall for cell phone charging. Additional porch shelter is also available.

Within the plaza is: Dollar Tree, Colebrook Chocolate (and ice cream), Wine and Spirits, New York Pasta and Pizza (along with sandwiches and meals) and Curtis Pharmacy.

Available just down the hill in Yough River Park next to the restroom/park building is water, river access, playground and pavilions

Comfort Inn Hotel is open on the other side of Yough River Park by GAP mile marker 88. In their lobby are restrooms with shower facilities for a small cost. Their webpage is: [Comfort Inn Connellsville](http://www.comfortinnConnellsville.com)

A bike shop – Bike's Unlimited – is available Tuesday through Sunday on 3<sup>rd</sup> St and Crawford Ave (at the traffic light on the trail crossing)

A bike loop into downtown is available from the trail on Meason Ave. and 3<sup>rd</sup> St to cross the bridge where most of the restaurant/businesses reside on the other side of the river. Maps are available at the Blue Building and a QR code in the shelters.

Foods available are: Italian, Mexican, Chinese, Family dining, fast food (McDonald's, Wendy's, Dominos, Dunkin' Donuts, Sheetz), Kickstand Kitchen, Bali Moon and Olde World Coffee and Gelato. From North at the blue building and South as you enter our town on the trail, there are information boards that will offer some guidance on food options, repair stations and other services available in our city.
